	Organic <sup>7</sup>	6 hens/m <sup>2</sup>	Not permitted <sup>8</sup>	Nest boxes (1 per 7 hens), litter on floor, perches (18cm per hen), scratching areas, natural light outdoors, shade and shelter. <sup>9</sup> Outdoor access for whole laying period <sup>10</sup> , smaller flock size(usually 2000 birds in a house). <sup>11</sup>
